NEW REGENT STREET

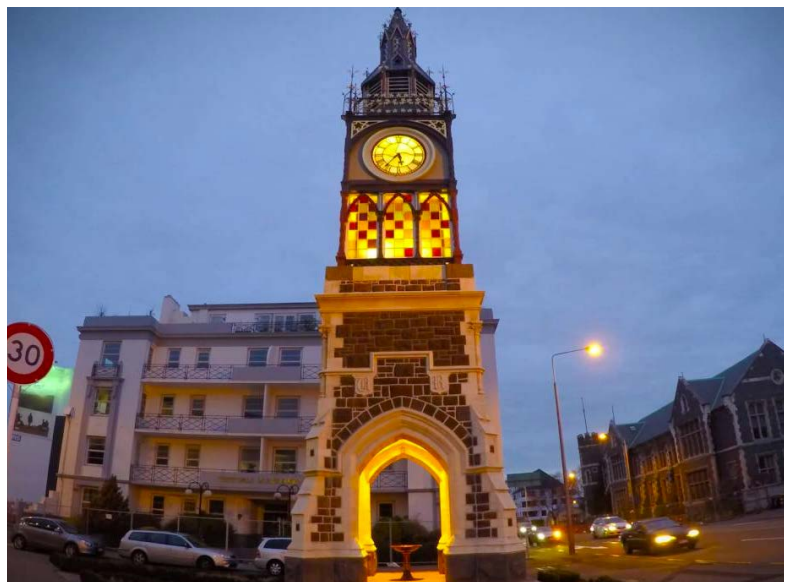
A block up from the playground and is a lovely example of beautiful Spanish Mission architecture.
